Highlights of the Regular Meeting
April 18, 2018

PUBLIC:

A parent asked to address the board about a student issue. The parent was asked to address the School Board during Closed Session.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Mr. Engelman presented on the following:

Mr. Engelman met with each teacher / content area to discuss "how to improve our SAT scores" and
what each department is doing and what else can be done to improve. He met separately with English,
Math, Social Students and Science teachers and had faculty meetings. Next year it is still unknown if
students are taking the SAT or ACT. The state of Illinois makes that decision. Last year we had 37
students take the test.

EVIDENCE-BASED FUNDING: This is a new school funding formula calculated by the State of Illinois. The state has looked at each school in Illinois (sizes of schools) and determined how much money they need based on about 25 different items. Schools were put into Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3 or Tier 4. GSW, along with the area feeder grade schools, are in Tier 1 (which receives the most money). GSW High School will be receiving approximately \$114,000 from the State. The funds received are calculated by looking at what the school receives in local and state revenue and the cost of what should be spent. The amounts received are meant to help fill that gap.

<u>IASB RESOLUTION PROPOSAL:</u> School boards are allowed to present amendments /editions /proposals to the IASB (Illinois Association of School Boards) regarding IASB policy. These will be presented / debated at the Fall Board Conference. Our district representative will attend this meeting. The GSW board will select a delegate for the conference.
