Three Conditions Are Required For Making Adequate Yearly Progress(AYP)

- 1. At least 95.0% tested for Reading & Mathematics for the All Group and Subgroups. If the current year's participation rates are less than 95%, the participation rate for AYP will be considered sufficient if the average of the current year and the preceding year is at least 95%, or if the average of the current year and the two preceding years is atleast 95%. Only actual participation rates are printed. If the participation rate printed is less than 95% but 'Met AYP' is 'Yes', it means the 95% condition was met by averaging.
- 2. At least 40.0% Meeting/Exceeding Standards for reading & mathematics for the All Group, and at least 37.0% for all Subgroups to compensate for error in measurement for smaller subgroup sizes, or meet Safe Harbor requirements ***
- 3. At least 89.0% Attendance Rate for elementary school Schools or at least 66.0% Graduation Rate for high school Schools. Unit Schools must meet both criteria.
